Briar Hill, Danby	YO21 2LZ	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable.
Houlsyke, Whitby	YO21 2LH	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable.
Commondale, Whitby	YO21 2HG	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. This is an isolated rural location with no other facilities in the event of an emergency and poor mobile phone coverage in the area.
Botton Hall, Danby	YO21 2NJ	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable. This is a popular tourist area.
West Bank, Scarborough	YO12 4DY	Agree	The Council has received no objections to the removal of this phone box.
Suffield, Scarborough	YO13 0BJ	Agree	The Council has received no objections to the removal of this phone box.
Royal Parade, Filey	YO14 9JZ	Object	The Council objects to the removal of this phone box. Strong objections have been received. It is often not possible to get a mobile signal on the beach and the phone box is therefore important for emergency calls to the Police and coastguard. The phone box is in a conservation area and there is a preference for the red style to be retained.
Osgodby Lane, Scarborough	YO11 3QE	Agree	The Council has received no objections to the removal of this phone box.
Manor View Road, Lebberston, Scarborough	YO11 3PB	Object	The Council objects to the removal of this phone box. There is a significant elderly population in the area and the area contains a number of caravan sites. There is no payphone at the Ox Inn nearby and therefore no alternative facilities.

High Street, Burniston, Scarborough	YO13 0HH	Object	The Council objects to the removal of this phone box and has received strong objections. It is considered locally that the phone box is little used now because it has been converted into a card only facility and these are not locally available. The local community would prefer it to be converted back to a coin and card facility, so enabling more people to use the facility.
Southfield, Reighton Gap, Scarborough	YO14 9SN	Object	The Council objects to the removal of this phone box and has received strong objections. The box is located on an isolated site on an exposed coastal location, where mobile phone signals can not be relied upon. It is felt important that at least an emergency only facility is retained.
Whitebridge Road, Uppang Lane, Whitby	YO21 3EA	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable.
Main Road, Aislaby, Whitby	YO21 1SW	Agree	Community objections have been received (northern area forum) and it is acknowledged that mobile phone quality is variable on some networks, although Orange is generally reliable in this location. On balance the Council does not object to the removal of this facility, the Parish Council have no objections and the phone has been out of order since Christmas. The facility is near the pub , so alternative facilities are available
Littlebeck, Whitby	YO22 5EY	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is poor especially in the valley bottom. It is 3 miles to next village and located on a popular walking route. The facility is, therefore, valuable for walkers in emergency situation.
Raw, Whitby	YO22 4PP	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. The phone box is some distance from nearby villages and mobile phone reception is sporadic and cannot be relied upon.

East Barnby, Whitby	YO21 3RZ	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable.
The Parade, Sandsend, Whitby	YO21 3SZ	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable.
Scar Lane, West Barnby, Whitby	YO21 3SD	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable.
O S post office, Front Street, Grosmont, Whitby	YO22 5PA	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable. The phone is located in a busy tourist area, some 2.5 miles to next village.
Fryup, Whitby	YO21 2AP	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. This is an isolated location, where mobile phone reception is poor. There are no shops or pubs in the area which could be used as an alternative.
Stonegate, Lealholm, Whitby	YO21 2AB	Object	The Council objects to the removal of a phone box in this rural area. Community objections have been received from the northern area forum. As is the case with much of the rural area in the north of the Borough mobile phone quality and signal is variable. The phone box is located on a river, close to a number of footpaths and bridleways and is therefore considered to be of value in the event of an emergency. It is some distance to any alternative phone facilities.
